**Never Alone: The Holy Spirit In Our Lives**  
**Indwelt by the Spirit – The Holy Spirit’s presence in our lives affirms our relationship with God.**

Romans 8:9-17

**The Holy Spirit** is God, and He is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity (*1 John 5:7 NKJV*). Also called: Holy Ghost, Spirit, Spirit of Truth, Spirit of God, Spirit of Christ. Also named for His purpose: Comforter, Counselor, Helper, Advocate.

**I. Romans 8:9-11 (The Holy Spirit Lives In Everyone who Trusts in Jesus)**

A. The Holy Spirit indwells or lives in everyone who places their trust in Jesus Christ. (vs. 9-11)

**John 14:16-17 (AMP); Ephesians 1:12-13; Acts 2:37-39 (AMP)**

B. Having the Holy Spirit in us means that we now have a new life. (vs. 9-11)  
**2 Corinthians 5:17 (AMP); Romans 8:1-2 (AMP); 1 Corinthians 6:9-11**

**II. Romans 8:12-14 (The Holy Spirit desires to guide the life of every Believer)**

A. We are no longer obligated to our past life because of our faith in Jesus.  
(vs. 12-14) (*Ephesians 2:1-5 ERV – In the past we lived a life of sin*)  
Romans 6:1-6; Luke 19:5-9

B. The Holy Spirit desires to lead or guide the life of every believer. (vs. 12-14)  
**John 16:13 (AMP); 1 Thessalonians 5:19 (AMP); Acts 8:29-30,35 (AMP)**

**III. Romans 8:15-17 (We are Joint Heirs with Jesus thru the Holy Spirit)**

A. We are adopted into the family of God by the Holy Spirit. (vs. 15-17)  
**Galatians 4:4-5 (TLB); John 1:12-13 (AMP)**

B. We are joint heirs with Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. (vs. 15-17)  
**John 15:18-20; Romans 8:18-19, 23 (AMP)**
