# Never Alone: The Holy Spirit In Our Lives Filled with the Spirit – The Holy Spirit's enables us to live as fully devoted disciples.

Ephesians 5:8-21

**The Holy Spirit** is God, and He is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity (*1 John 5:7 NKJV*). Also called: Holy Ghost, Spirit, Spirit of Truth, Spirit of God, Spirit of Christ. Also named for His purpose: Comforter, Counselor, Helper, Advocate.

## I. Ephesians 5:8-14 (We move from Children of Darkness to Light in Christ)

A. Before we placed our trust in Jesus Christ, we were children of darkness or sin. (vs. 8-14)

John 3:19-20; Romans 5:12; 1 John 3:8; John 8:44 (TLB)

B. When we placed our trust in Jesus Christ, we became children of light or righteousness, and we should walk or live in the light. (vs. 8-14)
Romans 13:12-13 (TLB); John 8:12; Acts 26:18; Matthew 5:14-16 (AMP)

# II. Ephesians 5:15-18 (Live Your Life under the Guidance of the Holy Spirit)

- A. Being filled with the Spirit or full of the Spirit is to live our life under the guidance or control of the Holy Spirit. (vs. 15-18) (*Acts 2:4; 4:8; 7:55*)
  John 16:13 (AMP); 1 Thessalonians 5:19 (AMP); Acts 13:2-4 (AMP)
- B. To be controlled by the Holy Spirit, we must understand the Lord's will by continually studying the Word of God. (vs. 15-18) (*Jn 7:17 Will/Word*) John 14:26; 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Timothy 2:15

## III. Ephesians 5:19-21 (The Spirit leads us to encourage others & be thankful)

- A. The Holy Spirit leads us to encourage one another. (vs. 19-21) Hebrews 10:24-25 (AMP); Acts 13:48; Acts 4:34-35 (AMP)
- B. The Holy Spirit leads us to be thankful to God. (vs. 19-21)
  1 Thessalonians 5:18; Psalm 34:1; 2 Corinthians 9:15 (TLB)
