Never Alone: The Holy Spirit In Our Lives
Walking with the Spirit – The Holy Spirit leads us to display the fruit of godly character.

Galatians 5:16-25

The Holy Spirit is God, and He is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity (*1 John 5:7 NKJV*). Also called: Holy Ghost, Spirit, Spirit of Truth, Spirit of God, Spirit of Christ. Also named for His purpose: Comforter, Counselor, Helper, Advocate.

I. Galatians 5:16-18 (Live Your Life by the Guidance of the Holy Spirit)

A. Even though we are saved from our sins, we can still live by the desires of our flesh, or we can still live in sin. (vs. 16-18)

Romans 6:1-2 (AMP); 2 Timothy 2:19; Ephesians 5:3-7

B. Since we are saved from our sins, we should walk or live our life by the guidance of the Holy Spirit. (vs. 16-18)

John 16:13 (AMP); 1 Thessalonians 5:19 (AMP); 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (AMP)

II. Galatians 5:19-21 (Fleshly Works include sexual sin & sin against others)

A. The works of the flesh includes sexual sin. (vs. 19)

Genesis 19:4-9 (ERV); 2 Samuel 11:2-5 (NLT)

B. The works of the flesh includes sin against others. (vs. 20-21)

1 Kings 21:5-14 (TLB); Acts 8:9-11

III. Galatians 5:22-25 (Spiritual Works include Faithfulness & Kindness)

A. The fruit or works of the Spirit includes faithfulness. (vs. 22-25)

Genesis 39:7-10; Daniel 3:16-18

B. The fruit or works of the Spirit includes kindness. (vs. 22-25)

Luke 10:33-35; Luke 19:8-9
