Staying True In A World Far From God Pray with Passion – Our prayers really do make a difference. Daniel 2:13-23, 27-28a

I. Daniel 2:13-16 (Be confident that God can make the impossible possible)

- A. Christians can find themselves in difficult situations or circumstances even if they haven't done anything wrong. (vs. 13)
 John 16:33; 1 Peter 4:12-13
- B. Christians must always be confident that God can make things that seem to be impossible possible. (vs. 14-16)
 Luke 1:37; Psalm 34:19; Romans 8:28; Hebrews 11:1, 6 (TLB)

II. Daniel 2:17-19 (The impossible can become possible if we pray)

- A. Things that seem to be impossible can become possible if we pray. (vs. 17-18)
 - John 16:23; James 5:16; Ephesians 3:20; Matthew 18:19-20
- B. God answers sincere prayer. (vs. 19) Philippians 4:6; 1 Samuel 1:9-11, 19-20; Luke 17:12-14 (AMP)

III. Daniel 2:20-23, 27-28a (When God answers prayer, give Him praise)

A. When God answers our prayer, we should then give Him praise or thanks. (vs. 20-23)

Psalm 107:31 (NLT); 1 Samuel 2:1-2; Luke 17:15-18 (AMP)

B. No one compares to the God of heaven. (vs. 27-28a) Psalms 40:5 (NLV); Daniel 3:26-29
