Confident in the Face of Hard Questions Is Hell Real? – Eternal punishment awaits those who do not follow Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-12

I. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-7a (Faith in Jesus doesn't exempt us from Persecution)

- A. Christians establish faith in Jesus Christ when they place their trust in Him. (vs. 3-7a)
 - John 3:16 (TLB); Romans 10:9-10 (TLB); Ephesians 1:13 (TLB)
- B. Faith in Jesus Christ does not exempt Christians from facing persecution in this world. (vs. 3-7a)
 1 Peter 5:8; John 15:18-20 (AMP); Psalm 34:19 (AMP)

II. 2 Thessalonians 1:7b-10 (In Heaven there is peace but in Hell punishment)

- A. Although Christians face persecution in this world, we will experience eternal peace in heaven. (vs. 10) Matthew 25:31-34; Luke 16:19-22, 25 (GW); Revelation 21:4
- B. Those who haven't placed their trust in Jesus Christ will experience eternal punishment in hell. (vs. 7b-9)
 Matthew 25:41, 46; Luke 16:23-25; Revelation 20:10, 15

III. 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 (Living Godly can convince others to trust Jesus)

- A. Our faith in Jesus Christ requires that we strive to live a godly life. (vs. 11) Luke 6:46; Romans 12:1-2; John 13:35
- B. When we strive to live a godly life, it glorifies God and can motivate or convince others to place their trust in Jesus Christ also. (vs. 11-12) John 12:32; Matthew 5:16; Acts 16:25-28, 30-31, 34
