A Name Like No Other

The Righteousness of God's Name – We can know righteousness when we know and walk with Jesus.

Jeremiah 23:5-6; Romans 3:10b-13, 21-26

God is Righteous because He is perfect, without sin or error, and just or fair.

I. Jeremiah 23:5-6 (By prophecy, Jesus would be a Righteous King & Savior)

A. It was prophesied that Jesus Christ would be a righteous King unlike all others. (vs. 5)

1 Samuel 13:13-14 (AMP); 2 Samuel 12:7-9; John 18:37-38 (GW)

B. It was prophesied that all of humanity could be saved or declared righteous because of the righteousness of Jesus Christ. (vs. 6)

Matthew 1:18-21; 2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT); Romans 5:18-19

II. Romans 3:10b-13 (Apart from God, there is no one who is righteous)

A. Apart from God, there is no one who is righteous. (vs. 10b-13)

Romans 5:12 (AMP); Psalm 51:5 (TLB); 2 Timothy 3:13 (TLB)

B. Apart from God, there is no one better than another. (vs. 10b-13)

John 8:3-11; Luke 18:9-14

III. Romans 3:21-26 (We are made righteous when we place our trust in Jesus)

A. We receive the righteousness of God or are made righteous when we place our trust in Jesus Christ. (vs. 21-25)

Romans 10:9; Ephesians 1:13

B. Once we are saved, God requires that we live or walk in righteousness. (vs. 26)

Matthew 6:33 (AMP); 2 Peter 1:5-9

“18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. 19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.”
