A Name Like No Other

The Salvation Expressed In God's Name – Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18-25

I. Isaiah 7:14 (It was prophesied God would become a man, born of a virgin)

- A. It was prophesied that God would become a man. (vs. 14)
1 John 5:7; John 1:1-3, 14; **Philippians 2:5-7 (NLV)**
- B. It was prophesied that God would be born into this world by a virgin conceiving a child. (vs. 14)
Luke 1:26-35; **Galatians 4:4 (GNT)**

II. Matthew 1:18-21 (Jesus was not under condemnation, He came to save us)

- A. The condemnation of Adam's sin, which passed to all men, was not passed on to Jesus Christ. (vs. 18-20)
Romans 5:12 (AMP); Psalm 51:5 (TLB); Hebrews 4:15 (AMP)
- B. Jesus came to save us all from our sins. (vs. 21)
John 3:16-18; **Romans 10:13 (ERV)**; Romans 10:9; Ephesians 1:13

III. Matthew 1:22-25 (God came to dwell with us & remains thru the Spirit)

- A. Whatever God prophesies or says will always come to pass. (vs. 22-25)
Numbers 23:19; Luke 2:4-7, 11-12, 21
- B. God came to dwell with us and remains with us through the indwelling Holy Spirit. (vs. 22-25)
John 1:10-12 (AMP); John 14:16-18, 26
