Owning A Faith That Matters Yielded Faith – Faith acknowledges the authority of Jesus. Luke 7:1-10

I. Luke 7:1-5 (Hearing about God builds our Faith to request of Him)

- A. Hearing about God and what He has done or can do builds our faith.
 (vs. 1-3) (*Our God is revealed in 3 persons: 1 John 5:7*)
 Romans 10:17; Matthew 18:14; Act 17:24-25 (AMP); Matthew 4:23
- B. Faith leads us to request of God the things we cannot do for ourselves.
 (vs. 3-5)
 John 15:5: Luke 1:37: Ephosions 3:20, 21: Philippians 4:6

II. Luke 7:6-8 (Faith requires humility & acknowledges Jesus authority)A. Faith requires humility. (vs. 6-7)

- James 4:10; Luke 18:10-14; 2 Chronicles 16:12-13 (AMP)
- B. Faith acknowledges the authority of Jesus Christ. (vs. 7-8) Philippians 2:5-11; Luke 5:4-5; Acts 3:2-6

III. Luke 7:9-10 (God acts on our behalf when we display Faith in Him)

- A. God is pleased when we display or express faith in Him. (vs. 9) Hebrews 11:1-2, 5-6; Matthew 25:20-21
- B. God acts on our behalf when we display or express faith in Him. (vs. 10)
 Luke 5:6-9; Acts 3:7-10
