Owning A Faith That Matters Confident Faith – Faith displaces worry. Luke 12:22-34

I. Luke 12:22-26 (Don't worry because worry doesn't solve anything)

A. God doesn't want us to worry because worry doesn't solve anything. (vs. 25-26)

Philippians 4:6 (AMP); Hebrews 11:6; **Luke 10:38-42 (ERV)**

B. God provides food for the animals, and we are more important to Him. (vs. 22-24)

Psalm 147:9 (CSB); Psalm 104:27 (NIV); Genesis 1:26-27

II. Luke 12:27-30 (Don't worry because God knows what we need)

- A. God doesn't want us to worry because He knows what we need. (vs. 29-30) Matthew 6:8; **Hebrews 4:13 (TLB)**; **1 Kings 8:39 (GW)**
- B. God clothes the vegetation in the field, and we are more important to Him. (vs. 27-28)

Psalm 147:8 (CEB); Isaiah 41:19-20 (GNT); John 3:16 (AMP)

III. Luke 12:31-34 (When we seek & follow God's ways our needs will be met)

A. God doesn't want us to worry instead He wants us to seek and follow the ways of His kingdom. (vs. 31-34)

John 18:36 (AMP); Matthew 6:33 (AMP); James 1:22

B. When we seek God's kingdom and follow His ways then all our needs will be met or provided. (vs. 31-34)
Psalm 84:11; Philippians 4:15, 19 (ERV); 1 Kings 17:1-6
