Owning A Faith That Matters Maturing Faith – Faith matures as we humbly obey God. Luke 17:1-10

A **Mature Christian** displays or shows that they have faith in God.

I. Luke 17:1-4 (Mature Christians will forgive all who have offended them)

A. A mature Christian understands that in this world people can offend us. (vs. 1)

John 16:33; 1 Peter 4:12-13 (ERV); 2 Timothy 3:10-12

B. A mature Christian is willing to forgive those who have offended them. (vs. 1-4)

Ecclesiastes 12:14 (CEB); Matthew 6:12, 14-15; Matthew 18:15-22

II. Luke 17:5-6 (Mature Christians understand that we need to trust God now)

- A. A mature Christian understands that you don't have to wait for faith, you just need to trust or depend on God now. (vs. 5-6) Hebrews 11:1, 6; Mark 11:22-23; James 1:22, 25
- B. When we trust or depend on God mighty things can happen for us. (vs 6) Matthew 9:27-30; **Joshua 10:12-14** (**TLB**); Matthew 14:24-29

III. Luke 17:7-10 (Mature Christians are servants & don't seek recognition)

- A. A mature Christian understands that we are servants of God. (vs. 7-8) Psalms 119:91; **2 Corinthians 6:4 (ERV)**
- B. A mature Christian understands that they don't deserve recognition, nor do they seek it. (vs. 9-10)Romans 12:1-2; Psalms 100:4-5
