It's All About Jesus The Death of Jesus – Jesus died to pay the debt of our sin. Luke 23:32-49

I. Luke 23:32-34 (Jesus was crucified even though He had not sinned)

- A. Jesus was crucified or suffered for all humanity, as if He was a criminal, even though He had not sinned. (vs. 32-33)
 Hebrews 4:14-15 (ERV); John 19:1-4 (NLT); Matthew 27:34-35 (ERV)
- B. Jesus was crucified or sacrificed so that we could be forgiven. (vs. 34) Ephesians 1:7 (ERV); Hebrews 9:28 (NLT)

II. Luke 23:35-43 (Jesus will save all those who place their trust in Him)

- A. Jesus came to save all humanity from their sins. (vs. 35-39) Romans 5:12 (GNT); Matthew 1:21 (NLV); Luke 2:10-11 (AMP)
- B. Jesus will save all those who place their trust in Him. (vs 40-43) **Romans 1:16 (AMP); Romans 10:9-10 (AMP);** Ephesians 1:13

III. Luke 23:44-49 (Jesus died so that all humanity could be saved)

- A. Jesus died so that all humanity could be saved from their sins. (vs. 44-47) Romans 6:23; Matthew 16:13; John 10:36; Romans 5:8; John 3:16
- B. Despite Jesus sacrificial death, many people will remain in darkness or not place their trust in Him. (vs. 48-49)
 1 Peter 2:9; 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (AMP); John 3:19-20
