#### It's All About Jesus

The Resurrection of Jesus – Jesus rose again to give us victory over death. Luke 24:1-8, 38-43

**The Resurrection of Jesus** is key to God's Salvation Plan according to Romans 10:9 which says, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.". Jesus died for our sins and was raised for our salvation.

### I. Luke 24:1-6a (The empty tomb & Angels proved that Jesus was risen)

- A. The empty tomb was one proof of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. (vs. 1-3) (*No one took Jesus body: Jn 19:34; Mk 16:1; Jn 20:19*) Matthew 27:59-66 (NLT); Matthew 28:1-4 (NLT); John 20:1-8
- B. Another proof was that Angels declared that Jesus was risen. (vs. 4-6a) Psalm 103:20; Matthew 28:5-7

# II. Luke 24:6b-8 (The Old Testament & Jesus prophesied of His resurrection)

- A. The Old Testament prophesied of Jesus suffering, death, and resurrection. (vs. 6b-8)
  - Isaiah 50:6; Isaiah 53:9, 12; **Psalms 16:9-10 (ERV)**
- B. Jesus prophesied of His own suffering, death, and resurrection. (vs 6b-8) Matthew 20:18-19; Mark 8:31; Luke 9:21-22

# III. Luke 24:38-43 (Jesus proved His resurrection by showing Himself alive)

- A. Jesus also proved His resurrection by showing Himself alive to His disciples and other followers. (vs. 38-43)
  - Mark 16:9-14; **1 Corinthians 15:6 (ERV)**
- B. Jesus also proved His resurrection by allowing His disciples and other followers to touch Him. (vs. 38-43)Matthew 28:9-10; John 20:26-28

### **Words of Encouragement:**

"5 And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. 6 He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. 7 And go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead; and, behold, he goeth before you into Galilee; there shall ye see him: lo, I have told you." Matthew 28:5-7 (KJV)
