### **It's All About Jesus**

**The Mission of Jesus Shared – The truth about Jesus is too big to keep to ourselves.**

Luke 24:44-53

#### **I. Luke 24:44-45 (The entire Bible is all about Jesus Christ)**

- A. The entire bible, Old and New Testament, is all about Jesus Christ. (vs. 44)  
John 1:45-49; **Luke 24:27 (AMP); John 20:30-31 (NLT); 2 Timothy 1:1 (NLT)**
- B. You must be taught God's Word to understand the bible. (vs. 44-45)  
**Ephesians 4:11-12 (NLT); 2 Timothy 2:15; Acts 8:30-31 (NLV)**

#### **II. Luke 24:46-47 (The Bible's central message is that salvation is available)**

- A. The central message of the bible is that Jesus died and was resurrected so that we could be forgiven of our sins and receive salvation. (vs. 46-47)  
**Romans 4:25 (CEV); Ephesians 1:7; Romans 10:9**
- B. Jesus wants Christians to tell the world that forgiveness and salvation is available if they repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ. (vs 46-47)  
**Acts 2:37-38 (NLT); Mark 16:15-16 (AMP); Ephesians 1:13**

#### **III. Luke 24:48-53 (To witnesses for Jesus we must depend on the Holy Spirit)**

- A. Christians must depend on the power of the Holy Spirit to be effective witnesses for Jesus Christ. (vs. 48-51)  
Acts 1:8; Ephesians 6:17; **1 Thessalonians 5:19 (AMP); Acts 10:19-20, 34-36**
- B. Christians should be committed to continually worshiping, praising, and sharing the message of Jesus Christ. (vs. 52-53)  
**Hebrews 10:25 (AMP); Hebrews 13:15-16; Mark 16:20**

#### **Words of Encouragement:**

**“15 And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. 16 He who has believed [in Me] and has been baptized will be saved [from the penalty of God's wrath and judgment]; but he who has not believed will be condemned.” Mark 16:15-16 (AMP)**
