

How To Handle Life's Interruptions
When God Interrupts Your Life – The best interruptions come from God.
Hebrews 11:8-19

Interruption is a change or stoppage of your normal or regular activity.

I. Hebrews 11:8-12 (God interrupts our lives when He calls us to follow Him)

- A. God interrupts our lives when we accept His call to follow Him by faith.
(vs. 8-10) (*All of humanity was condemned to death: Romans 5:12 GNT*)
John 3:16-17 (AMP); Romans 8:1-2 (AMP); Matthew 16:24 (AMP)
- B. God's interruptions always turn out for the good of those who follow Him by faith. (vs. 11-12) (*All things work together for good: Romans 8:28*)
Genesis 37:26-28 (TLB); Genesis 39:11-12, 16-20 (TLB); Genesis 50:18-20 (TLB)

II. Hebrews 11:13-16 (God interrupts our lives so we can go to heaven)

- A. God's greatest promise or interruption is for us to be in Heaven with Him.
(vs. 13-16)
John 14:1-3; 1 Peter 1:3-5 (ESV)
- B. All who place their faith or trust in Jesus will go to heaven. (vs. 13-16)
Philippians 3:20 (AMP); 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 (TLB)

III. Hebrews 11:17-19 (God interrupts our lives by testing our faith in Him)

- A. God interrupts our lives by testing our faith in Him. (vs. 17-19)
Luke 6:46; Daniel 3:14-15; Luke 5:4-5 (AMP)
- B. We pass the faith test if we obey God's Word. (vs. 17-19)
Daniel 3:16-18, 23-25 (TLB); Luke 5:6-7 (EXB)
