

How To Handle Life's Interruptions
When Life Goes Terribly Wrong – Even hard interruptions place us where
God can use us.
Hebrews 11:8-19

Interruption is a change or stoppage of your normal or regular activity.

I. Genesis 39:21-23 (Despite interruptions, we should remain faithful to God)

A. Despite interruptions in our lives, we should remain faithful to God.

(vs. 21-23)

John 16:33 (EXB); 2 Timothy 3:12 (EXB); Colossians 1:10; Genesis 39:7-9, 11-12, 16-20 (TLB)

B. If we are faithful, God will bless us in the midst of life's interruptions.

(vs. 21-23)

Genesis 39:1-4 (TLB); Daniel 1:8, 16-20 (ERV)

II. Genesis 40:5-8 (Seek God because He has answers for life interruptions)

A. Although we have interruptions in our life, God still wants us to be concerned about the life interruptions that others face. (vs. 5-8)

John 13:34; Galatians 6:10 (AMP); Acts 16:23-28

B. We should always seek God's help because He has the answers for everyone's life interruptions. (vs. 8)

Proverbs 2:6 (AMP); Philippians 4:6 (AMP)

III. Genesis 41:10-14 (All things will work out for good to all who're faithful)

A. God will create the circumstances for the faithful to be blessed. (vs. 10-14)

Genesis 40:21-23 (AMP); Genesis 41:1, 8 (AMP)

B. All things will work out for good to all who're faithful to God. (vs. 14)

Romans 8:28 (KJV); Genesis 50:18-20 (TLB)

Words of Encouragement:

"18 Then his brothers came and fell down before him and said, 'We are your slaves.' 19 But Joseph told them, 'Don't be afraid of me. Am I God, to judge and punish you? 20 As far as I am concerned, God turned into good what you meant for evil, for he brought me to this high position I have today so that I could save the lives of many people.'" Genesis 50:18-20 (TLB)
