From Problems To Praise

From Problems To Praise – Thank God and praise Him for how He answers prayer.

Isaiah 38:9-20

I. Isaiah 38:9-14 (When we experience problems, we should pray to God)

- A. In this world we will experience problems, even those who strive to live godly. (vs. 9-13) (*Hezekiah lived godly or did what was right: 2 Chronicles 29:1-2; Hezekiah was sick and about to die: Isaiah 38:1*) **John 16:33 (AMP); Job 14:1 (NLT); 2 Timothy 3:12; John 11:1-2**
- B. When we experience problems in this world, we should take them to God in prayer. (vs. 14) (*Hezekiah prayed about his problem: Isaiah 38:2-3*) **Proverbs 2:6 (AMP); Jeremiah 32:17 (TLB); Philippians 4:6 (NLT); John 11:3 (ERV)**

II. Isaiah 38:15-17 (When we pray to God, He will answer us & deliver us)

- A. When we pray to God about our problems, He will answer us. (vs. 15a) (*God answered Hezekiah's prayer: Isaiah 38:4-5*) **Isaiah 30:19 (AMP); John 11:4-7 (ERV); 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 (ERV)**
- B. If God gives us a “yes” answer, then He will deliver us just as He said. (vs. 15b-17) (*God delivered or healed Hezekiah: 2 Kings 20:5-7 NLT*) **Numbers 23:19 (ESV); Joshua 21:45 (ESV); John 11:17, 21, 39-44**

III. Isaiah 38:18-20 (When God delivers us, we should thank or praise Him)

- A. When God delivers us, we should thank or praise Him. (vs. 18-20) **Psalm 107:6, 8; Psalm 34:1, 6; Psalm 100:1-2, 5; John 11:45**
- B. When God delivers us, we should testify to others about His goodness. (vs. 19b) **Psalms 71:15 (ERV); Luke 8:38-39 (AMP)**

Words of Encouragement:

“15 I will tell people how good you are. I will tell about all the times you saved me— too many times to count.” Psalms 71:15 (ERV)
