How To Handle Life's Interruptions
When Doing God's Work Is Interrupted – God may interrupt us to move our
ministry in a new direction.
Acts 16:4-15

Interruption is a change or stoppage of your normal or regular activity.

I. Acts 16:4-5 (Christians are to learn and live by God's Word)

- A. Christians are to learn and observe or live by God's Word. (vs. 4)
1 Peter 2:2; 2 Timothy 2:15; James 1:22-25
- B. As we learn or study God's Word our faith is strengthened. (vs. 5)
Romans 10:17; **Psalm 119:11 (ESV); Romans 4:18-21 (CSB)**

II. Acts 16:6-10 (The Holy Spirit came to guide us & we should obey Him)

- A. God gave us the Holy Spirit to lead or guide our lives. (vs. 6-10)
Ephesians 1:12-13 (CSB); John 14:17 (AMP); John 16:13 (EASY)
- B. As Christians, we should be obedient to the Holy Spirit's guidance.
(vs. 6-10)
1 Thessalonians 5:19 (AMP); Acts 8:26-31; Acts 10:17-23

III. Acts 16:11-15 (Follow the Spirit's guidance & some folk will trust in Jesus)

- A. As we follow the Holy Spirit's guidance, we will have the opportunity to share God's Word with others. (vs. 11-13)
Acts 1:8; Acts 8:34-35; Acts 10:34-36
- B. When we share God's Word with others, some folk will respond by believing or trusting in Jesus Christ. (vs. 14-15)
Acts 8:36-38; Acts 10:44-46

"13 But the Spirit will come. He is the one who shows people true things about God. When he comes, he will be a guide to you. He will help you to understand everything that is true. He will not speak on his own authority. He will tell you only what he hears from the Father. He will tell you about things that will happen after this time." John 16:13 (EASY)
