

How To Handle Life's Interruptions
When Your Actions Cause An Interruption – God can redeem our mistakes.
Exodus 2:11-22; 3:5-10

Interruption is a change or stoppage of your normal or regular activity.

I. Exodus 2:11-15 (We cause interruptions if we act without God's direction)

- A. We should always seek God's help because He has the answers for everyone's life interruptions. (vs. 11-12)
Proverbs 3:5-6; Proverbs 2:6 (AMP); Philippians 4:6 (AMP)
- B. We cause interruptions in our own life if we act without God's direction. (vs. 11-15)
Proverbs 14:12 (AMP); 1 Samuel 13:8-14 (AMP)

II. Exodus 2:16-22 (Be concerned about interruptions that others face)

- A. Although we have interruptions in our life, God still wants us to be concerned about the life interruptions that others face. (vs. 16-17)
Luke 23:39-43; Philippians 2:4 (AMP); Galatians 6:10 (AMP)
- B. When we show concern for others, we will be blessed. (vs. 18-22)
Proverbs 19:17 (AMP); Luke 6:38 (AMP)

III. Exodus 3:5-10 (If we trust God, He will redeem us & use us in His service)

- A. God knows about the interruptions that we all face. (vs. 5-10)
Hebrews 4:13 (ERV); Psalm 33:13-15 (GNT); Psalm 139:2-3 (CEV)
- B. If we put our trust in God, then He will redeem us and use us in His service. (vs. 5-10)
Titus 2:14 (AMP); Ephesians 1:12-13; Acts 1:8 (AMP)

Words of Encouragement:

"14 who [willingly] gave Himself [to be crucified] on our behalf to redeem us and purchase our freedom from all wickedness, and to purify for Himself a chosen and very special people to be His own possession, who are enthusiastic for doing what is good." Titus 2:14 (AMP)
