Limited Resources, Limitless God
When Your Confidence Falls Short – We can stand victoriously because of Christ.

1 John 3:21-4:6

- I. **1 John 3:21-24 (Be confident in your salvation & blessing when we obey)**
- A. Humans can be confident that we will be saved if we put our trust or belief in Jesus Christ. (vs. 21-24)
John 3:16; Romans 10:9; Ephesians 1:13; **John 10:27-29 (AMP)**
 - B. Christians can be confident that God can bless us or provide us with whatever we ask if we obey His Word. (vs. 21-24)
Ephesians 3:20; **Psalm 84:11 (AMP)**; John 15:10, 7
- II. **1 John 4:1-3 (Don't let false prophets shake your confidence in God)**
- A. Our confidence in God can be shaken if we follow the guidance of false prophets. (vs. 1)
Matthew 24:11; Matthew 7:15; **Jeremiah 23:16 (TLB)**
 - B. God has given us ways to identify false prophets so that we don't follow their guidance. (vs. 2-3) (*Check words with scripture: Acts 17:11 ERV*)
Matthew 1:18-21, 25 (TLB); Philippians 2:5-8 (TLB); Deuteronomy 18:21-22 (TLB)
- III. **1 John 4:4-6 (Be confident in God's great power & in following Him)**
- A. Our confidence should always be in God because there is no power greater than His. (vs. 4)
Jeremiah 10:6 (EXB); Philippians 2:9-11 (EXB)
 - B. Our confidence in God is maintained if we continually listen to and follow or obey God's Word. (vs. 5-6)
2 Timothy 2:15; **Matthew 7:24-27 (EXB)**

“10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. 7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.” John 15:10, 7 (KJV)
