Limited Resources, Limitless God
When Your Finances Falls Short – Trust in God is far richer than financial prosperity.
Luke 12:13-21; 21:1-4

- I. Luke 12:13-15 (Our primary focus is to love God & others but not money)**
- A. As Christians, our primary focus is to love God and love others.
(vs. 13-15) (*Acknowledging God shows that we love Him: Lk 12:8-9 CSB*)
Matthew 22:35-40; John 13:34-35; **Galatians 6:10 (LSB)**
 - B. As Christians, our primary focus is not to love money or to seek things.
(vs. 15) (*Physical needs are not our primary focus: Mat 4:1-4 AMP*)
Matthew 6:31-33; **1 Timothy 6:9-10 (AMP)**
- II. Luke 12:16-21 (God blesses some of us with more things than we need)**
- A. God blesses some of us with more things than we need. (vs. 16-18)
1 Samuel 2:7 (NLT); Deuteronomy 8:18 (AMP); Job 34:19 (AMP)
 - B. Some are blessed with more than they need so that they can be a blessing to others. (vs. 19-21)
1 Timothy 6:17-18 (AMP); 1 John 3:17 (NLT); Ecclesiastes 5:10 (ESV); Luke 16:19-24
- III. Luke 21:1-4 (God expects us to give and He blesses us accordingly)**
- A. God expects Christians to be givers. (vs. 1-2)
Proverbs 3:9; Malachi 3:8-9 (CEV)
 - B. God blesses us based on or according to our giving. (vs. 3-4)
2 Corinthians 9:6; Luke 6:38; Proverbs 3:10; Malachi 3:10-12 (CEV)
