God Is: Understanding The Character Of God
God is Faithful – God is faithful to His people and His promises.
Deuteronomy 7:6-16

Faithful is to be consistent and trustworthy.

I. Deuteronomy 7:6-8 (God faithfully loves His people & keeps His promises)

- A. God faithfully loves His people. (vs. 6-8) (*Gen 22:15-18; Gal 3:8, 16*)
Psalm 24:1 (ERV); Genesis 1:27-28 (ERV); John 3:16-18 (EASY)
- B. God faithfully keeps His promises. (vs. 8b)
Genesis 15:12-14 (AMP); Exodus 12:40-42; Isaiah 53:5, 8, 10 (AMP); Romans 4:25 (CEV)

II. Deuteronomy 7:9-11 (God faithfully blesses those who obey His Word)

- A. God faithfully blesses those who keep His commands or obey His Word.
(vs. 9-11)
Psalm 84:11 (NLT); John 15:7 (TLB); Joshua 10:12-14 (CEV)
- B. God faithfully punishes those who hate His commands or disobey His Word.
(vs. 10-11)
Proverbs 11:21 (ERV); Acts 12:21-23 (AMP); Acts 5:1-5 (TLB)

III. Deuteronomy 7:12-16 (For continual blessings, we must obey God's Word)

- A. To continually receive God's blessings, we must faithfully continue to listen to or study His Word. (vs. 12-16)
Psalm 119:105 (ERV); 2 Timothy 2:15
- B. To continually receive God's blessings, we must faithfully continue to keep or obey His Word. (vs. 12-16)
James 1:25; Joshua 1:8

Words of Encouragement:

“16 God loved the people in the world so much that he gave his one and only Son to save them. As a result, everyone who believes in the Son will not die. Instead, they will live for ever with God.’ 17 God did not send his Son into the world because he wanted to punish people. He sent his Son to save the people in the world from punishment. 18 God will not punish anyone who believes in his Son. But if people refuse to believe in the Son, God has already decided that he must punish them. They have not believed in God's one and only Son.”
