God Is: Understanding The Character Of God
God is Just – Because God is righteous, He alone establishes justice.
Psalm 7:1-13

- I. Psalm 7:1-5 (If you are troubled unjustly then take your concerns to God)**
- A. If you are experiencing trouble unjustly then take your concerns to God in prayer. (vs. 1-5) (*The godly will have trouble: 2 Timothy 3:12 EASY*)
Psalm 46:1 (AMP); Philippians 4:6; 1 Peter 5:7; Luke 18:1-8 (AMP)
 - B. We should always make sure that our actions aren't the cause of the trouble that we are facing. (vs. 3-5) (*The wicked will have trouble: Prov 12:21*)
2 Samuel 12:7-11 (ERV); Luke 23:39-41 (AMP)
- II. Psalm 7:6-9 (Tell God your concerns because He knows all & judges fairly)**
- A. We should take our concerns or troubles to God because He alone knows exactly what everyone has done. (vs. 6-9)
Hebrews 4:13 (AMP); Proverbs 15:3 (AMP); Psalm 139:1-4 (AMP)
 - B. We should take our concerns or troubles to God because He alone will judge everyone fairly. (vs. 6-9)
Psalms 9:7-8 (CEB); Romans 2:9-11 (CEB); Genesis 20:2-6
- III. Psalm 7:10-13 (God will deliver the righteous & repentant from trouble)**
- A. God will deliver the righteous and those who repent of their sins from their concerns or trouble. (vs. 10-13)
Psalms 34:19; 2 Chronicles 7:14
 - B. God will bring judgement upon all who don't repent of their sins.
(vs. 11-13) (*It's not God's desire that perish but all repent: 2 Peter 3:9*)
Luke 17:3-4 (AMP); Acts 5:1-2, 7-11 (CSB)
