Seize The Day: Embracing A Mission With Purpose
A Mission With A Message – We can have a relationship with God through
Christ alone.
Acts 3:12-20, 24-26

- I. **Acts 3:12-15 (The central message of God is that Jesus died & rose for us)**
- A. Sometimes God uses miracles to get people’s attention so that God’s Word can be preached. (vs. 12)
Acts 2:4-14; Acts 16:25-30
 - B. The central message of God’s Word is that Jesus died for our sins and was raised to make us right or to renew our relationship with God. (vs. 13-15)
Romans 5:12; 1 Corinthians 15:3; **Romans 4:25 (NLV)**
- II. **Acts 3:16-20 (To renew our relationship with God, we must trust in Jesus)**
- A. To be saved, or to renew our relationship with God, we must first repent of our sins. (vs. 16-19)
1 John 1:9; 2 Chronicles 7:14
 - B. To be saved, or to renew our relationship with God, we must also put our faith or trust in Jesus Christ. (vs. 20)
John 3:16-17; **John 8:24 (TLB)**; Romans 10:9-10; Ephesians 1:13
- III. **Acts 3:24-26 (God sent Jesus so that He could save all humanity from sin)**
- A. God promised that all the families of the earth or all humanity would be blessed through Abraham’s offspring or seed. (vs. 24-25)
Genesis 12:1-3; Matthew 1:1; Galatians 3:8, 14
 - B. God sent Jesus so that He could save all humanity from their sins, starting with the Jews first and then the Gentiles. (vs. 26)
Galatians 3:28; **Revelation 7:9 GW**); 1 Corinthians 6:9-11
