Connecting With Others Like Jesus Did
Showing Love – We are called to love God and love others.
Luke 10:25-37

- I. Luke 10:25-28 (Those who trust in Jesus Christ must love God & others)**
- A. Eternal life is not obtained by our works but only by putting our trust in Jesus Christ. (vs. 25-28) (*All have sinned: Romans 5:12 GNT*)
Romans 3:20 (AMP); John 3:16-17, 36; Ephesians 1:13; John 10:24-29
 - B. Those who have put their trust in Jesus Christ must love God and others. (vs. 25-28) (*Love is proof of our new life in Jesus: 1 John 3:14 TLB*)
John 14:23 (EASY); John 13:34-35; **Galatians 6:10 (AMP)**
- II. Luke 10:29-32 (God expects Christians to show love to those in need)**
- A. In this world we will experience all types of evil because of sin. (vs. 29-30)
1 John 3:4 (GW); **Genesis 6:5 (CEB)**; **Galatians 5:19-21 (CEB)**
 - B. God expects Christians to show love to or help those in need. (vs. 31-32)
1 John 3:17-18; Matthew 25:42-45
- III. Luke 10:33-37 (When we show love to the needy, we are loving God)**
- A. The greatest example of love or help for the needy was, is being, and will be shown by God for us all. (vs. 33-37)
Matthew 1:21; **Romans 4:25 (CEV)**; Romans 8:34; **John 14:3 (CEB)**
 - B. When we show love to or help those in need, we are showing love to God. (vs. 33-37)
1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (CEB); **1 John 4:19 (GNT)**; Matthew 25:34-40
