Essentials For Christian Living
A Humble Attitude – Humility calls for faithfulness to Christ.
1 Corinthians 3:18 – 4:7

I. 1 Corinthians 3:18-23 (It's unwise to take sides with anyone but God)

A. God is the only source of true wisdom. (vs. 18-20)

Proverbs 2:6 (ERV); Jeremiah 8:9 (GW); Proverbs 14:12; James 1:5

B. It's foolish or unwise to take sides with or to worship anyone but God.

(vs. 21-23) (*Songs: It's not about us & Who's on the Lord's side*)

Matthew 4:8-10 (AMP); 1 Corinthians 3:6-7 (AMP); Exodus 32:26;

1 Corinthians 11:1 (TLB)

II. 1 Corinthians 4:1-5 (God requires that His servants serve Him faithfully)

A. Regardless of our assignments, we are all just servants of God. (vs 1)

Galatians 1:10 (NLT); 2 Peter 1:1; Romans 1:1

B. God requires that all of His servants serve Him faithfully. (vs. 2-5)

(Jesus served His Father faithfully: John 17:1-4)

Micah 6:8 (AMP); 2 Timothy 2:15; James 1:22, 25; 2 Corinthians 5:10 (AMP)

III. 1 Corinthians 4:6-7 (Remember God gave us all assignments and gifts)

A. Remember that God gave us all assignments to perform in support of His church. (vs. 6-7)

Romans 12:3-5 (AMP); Ephesians 4:11-12

B. Remember that God gave us all spiritual gifts to perform our assignments. (vs. 6-7)

1 Corinthians 12:4 (AMP); Romans 12:6-8 (ERV)

Words of Encouragement:

“8 He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you Except to be just, and to love [and to diligently practice] kindness (compassion), And to walk humbly with your God [setting aside any overblown sense of importance or self-righteousness]?” Micah 6:8 (AMP)
